Solar I

The Solar I Course offers an informative, instructive, and “enlightening” opportunity to learn skills in organizing, developing and establishing a project partnership with a community in another part of the world. Participants will be illumined with insights about forming and nurturing mission teams. They will also learn how to evaluate potential locations, manage a solar project and negotiate a covenant agreement with a partner-in-need.

Solar II

Students in the Solar 2 Course will learn to assemble a small (1 - 6 photovoltaic panels) off-grid solar energy system for use in an in-country institutional setting. Emphasis is on systems to power clean water systems, but other applications such as lighting are highlighted. The class includes hands-on experience with SUTS’s solar trailer, understanding system components, assessing the electrical load, system design, plus safety and maintenance.

Solar Under the Sun is designed to provide the necessary training to churches and organizations, enabling them to install solar power in places of great need. We partner with nonprofit communities to help them alleviate financial hardship while becoming better stewards of God’s green earth.

Solar School is required for groups who want to participate in Solar Under the Sun (SUTS). Each group (church, presbytery, organization) must send 2 people to Solar School: One for each course. Groups may send up to 4 people: Two for each course.

Courses: Solar I and Solar II are held concurrently at Ferncliff Camp and Conference Center in Arkansas.

Mission priority: Haiti

Our pilot project in 2009 was the full installation of a clean water system in Haiti to run on solar energy, in cooperation with our partners, Living Waters for the World (LWW). The 2010 earthquake has prompted urgent need to continue that work in Haiti.

Training Information

Cost

- \$500 for first registrant from church/organization
- \$450 for each additional registrant from church/organization

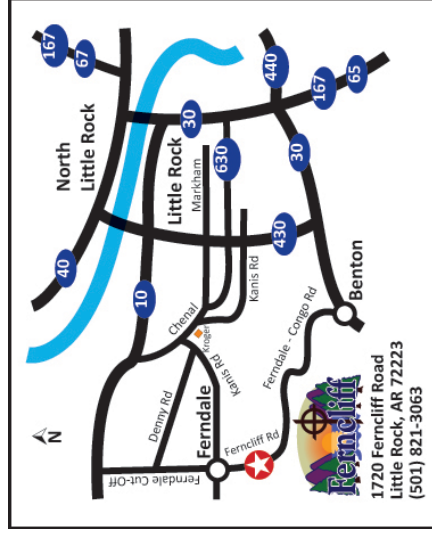
Cost includes training materials, room & board. Room & board is double occupancy only.
