Solar Under the Sun is designed to provide the necessary training to churches and organizations to enable them to install solar power in places of great need. Solar groups partner with nonprofit communities to help them meet community needs while becoming better stewards of God's green earth.

## Mission priority: Haiti

- limited availability)

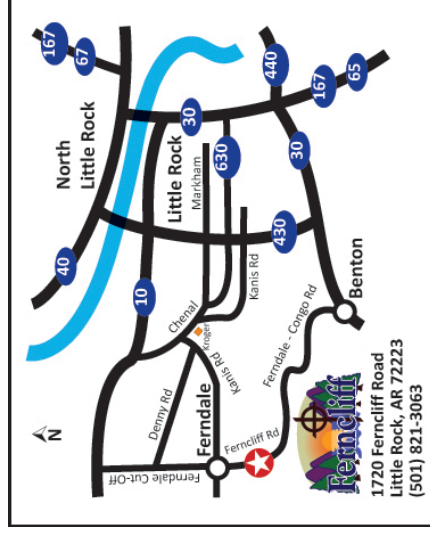
Cost includes training materials, room & board.
